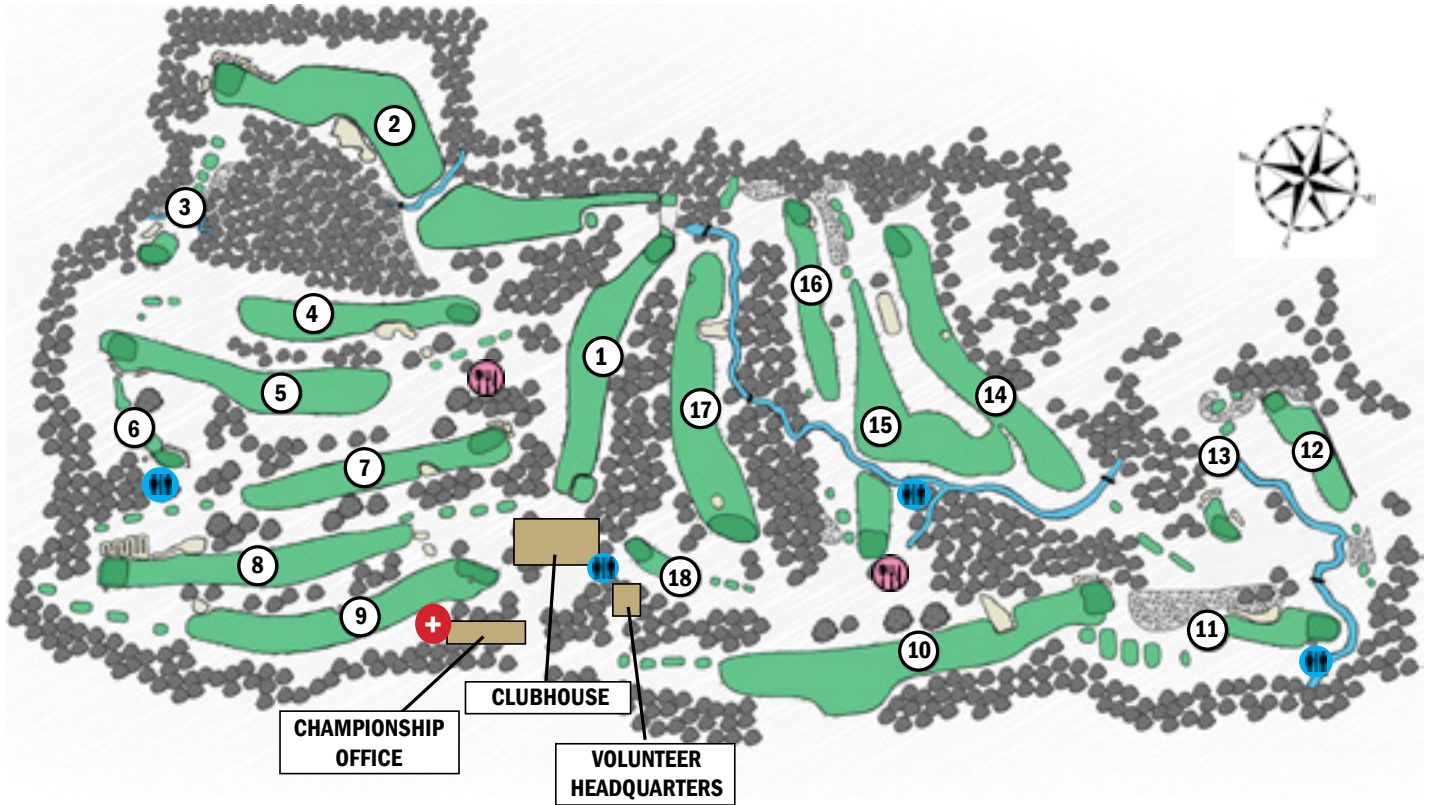

IMPORTANT NOTE: Contestants will **only** receive lodging reimbursement if they stay at the Hilton Hartford. Lodging reimbursement is \$50 per night for up to 5 nights.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT POLICIES

The PGA of America will provide a travel **AND** lodging stipend to help cover part of your Championship expenses. A contestant must complete 36 holes to be reimbursed.

The process for reimbursement is two-fold. A player receives \$50/night for up to 5 nights at the Hilton Hartford **AND** the player receives up to the maximum for travel based on your timezone. Travel expense includes: player plane ticket/baggage fees, car rental, fuel and tolls.

TRAVEL EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT BASED BY TIME ZONE OF PLAYER'S HOME ADDRESS

Central Time:	Maximum \$300/player

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Reimbursed:	Rental car, gas receipts and/or tolls (for rental vehicle or your own vehicle)
Required:	All receipts must be uploaded in reimbursement form (turning in mileage/itineraries will NOT suffice for reimbursement)

AIR TRANSPORTATION

Reimbursed:	Airline ticket & baggage (Player only, up to the maximum for your timezone)
Required:	All receipts must be uploaded in reimbursement form (Please include a receipt that shows form of payment.)

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT POLICIES

LODGING

Reimbursed:	\$50 per night
Maximum:	Up to five (5) nights (\$250)
Limit:	One room per family
Eligibility:	Players must stay at the Hilton Hartford to be eligible for reimbursement. You must submit a receipt.

PLEASE NOTE: We only accept receipts that show a payment transaction - itineraries and/or reservations will not be accepted. We must see the balance paid in full for airfare, car rental, hotel, fuel and tolls.

The following AJGA Performance Based Entry (PBE) will be awarded at the Boys Junior PGA Championship:

Rank 1 - 15 = Fully Exempt
Rank 16 - 25 = 12 Stars
Top 50% = 8 Stars



CONTESTANT INFORMATION

STARTING PROCEDURE

PGA Officials will not call contestants to the starting tee. It is the contestant's responsibility to be in place and ready to start at her assigned tee and starting time.

CADDIES/PUSH CARTS

The Boys Junior PGA Championship is a "walking only" championship. Caddies are not permitted. Contestants must carry their own clubs. However, the use of non-motorized push cart is allowed. Keney Park Golf Course has a limited number of push carts available to rent on a first come, first served basis. Please note there is no bag drop or club storage available.

Contestants are reminded that during the championship rounds, they are not allowed to accept rides on any vehicles, unless specifically directed by a member of the PGA of America Rules Committee. There is a 2-stroke penalty for a ride on any unauthorized vehicle.

Caddies are allowed **ONLY** during practice rounds.

INSTRUCTORS

Only one instructor is allowed on the practice putting green with each contestant prior to each round. All other parents/coaches/friends of the contestants are not allowed on the practice putting green.

SPECTATOR POLICIES

SPECTATOR POLICY

In order to provide the fairest environment for competition, please refrain from addressing any player while he warms up, plays a competitive round, and before he signs his scorecard.

Please stay outside of any roped areas. Do not walk across fairways while competition is in progress. Remain stationary when you are in the field of view of a player executing a shot. Polite applause is appreciated. Never celebrate the misfortunes of a competitor.

Smoking, vaping, and alcohol consumption on the golf course are forbidden. Thank you for disposing of trash, picking up litter and helping keep our beautiful grounds clean.

Please note, cameras ARE allowed, as well as small folding chairs, as there are no grandstands for sitting. We ask that you be respectful of players and other spectators and refrain from photography that would be distracting.

Please keep your cell phone on “silent” or “vibrate” when on property, please no calls, videos, or photos within 100 yards of play.

SPECTATOR GOLF CARS

No spectator golf cars are allowed any day of Championship week. Keney Park **does not** have electric or motorized scooters to rent. There **will not** be handicap transportation provided. Please make your own arrangements. If you have any further questions, please contact the Championship Staff.

Please bring comfortable walking shoes.
